INTRODUCTION	
Read John 19:38–20:10. What do you see? What stands out?	
DISCUSSION	
Re-read this passage. In what ways is the resurrection of Jesus a center-piece to our faith? Why is it so important?	
Read John 19:39-40. Josh talked about Joseph of Arimathea and Nicodemus who prepared Jesus body for burial and who placed Him in the tomb. These were men who previously had been afraid to come to Jesus (John 3 and Luke 23:51). What do you think prompted them to be this bold and direct as to spend all of this money, time, and risk to do this now?	
Read 1 Corinthians 15:17–19 and Romans 6:5-6. What difference does it make knowing that because Jesus was raised from the dead, you will be too? How does that impact how you live?	
Josh talked about the Greek words for 'saw' referring to when Peter and John looked into the tomb. Read John 20:5 and 6. The first word is 'observe', the next is 'investigate' and the third is 'inward conviction'. How might this relate to your own story of coming to Jesus and seeing Him rightly?	
■ Read Revelation 1:17-18. How does the reality of the Risen Christ fuel your worship, awe, and devotion?
