Practical Care Tasks/Skills (examples)

- Cooking
- Driving/Transportation

- Administration
- Funeral Support
- Financial Peace University and financial counseling

Winter Shelter Network

A partnership with Douglas County Cares and 9 other churches and agencies in Douglas County.


- Providing a safe, warm bed and a listening ear.
- Helping them become self-sustaining.
- 15 woman and kids helped in 2017/2018.
- 93 Grace Chapel volunteers serving through the five months.



Extension of the Winter Shelter

Supporting Single Moms

- Providing rental assistance.
- Community care to Single Moms in the surrounding counties.
- Providing services that help them reach self-sustainability, meals, childcare, and Gals night out.
- Emotional and spiritual support through the tough times.
- Practical help and small repairs around the house.



Act for the Refugee


A partnership between Denver Rescue Mission and Grace Chapel.

- Building friendships, teaching English, and caring for them.
- Taking them for medical appointments.
- In 2017/2018, three families from Bhutan, Nepal, and Central African Republic were helped.
- Nine volunteers from Grace Chapel provided this caring service.



Move In Ministries

- Butch and Kathy Ross have lived in the Elevation apartment complex since May 2017.
- Providing hospitality through special monthly social events.
- Organizing prayer times.
- Social gatherings for encouragement and prayer.
- Welcoming the new tenants.
- Assisting the management with special events.
- Providing assistance to struggling tenants.



The Hope of Denver Biblical Counseling Center

We committed to: Build the foundation for a future biblical counseling ministry of Grace Chapel.

So far we have:

- Found a name: The Hope of Denver
- Trained 30+ people
- 6 People through ACBC exams
- Established foundational documents and process
- Began taking counselees

The Hope of Denver will be opening soon and able to provide free, short-term, goal-centered, and Bible-based counseling.
