## DAY 1

### Verse Wrap

Write out the words of the verse on separate pieces of paper and place them in a gift bag. Take one piece of paper out at a time with your family and work together to put them in order. Then read the verse aloud.

## DAY 2

### The Best Gift Ever

What is the best gift you've ever received on Christmas?

Why was it the best gift?

The best gift ever isn't one that you can wrap and place under the tree. And it isn't a gift you receive because of anything you do. God gave us the greatest gift over 2,000 years ago when He sent Jesus! That's what Christmas is really all about. Happy Birthday, Jesus!

## DAY 3

### Wrap it Up

Write the word "Jesus" on a card and wrap it up in a small box. Place it under your Christmas tree with a gift tag that reads, "For everyone!" On Christmas morning, pick someone in your family to open the gift. When they read the card, talk about how Jesus is the greatest gift!
