**MORNING TIME**

Write the verse for this month in a place where the whole family can see it (fridge, family chalkboard, etc.). When you see your child in the morning, point it out to them, read it with them and encourage them to do this each morning before leaving to help them memorize it.



**DRIVE TIME**

While in the car ask your preteen, "What do you need to trust God with right now? What makes it hard to trust God sometimes?"



**MEAL TIME**
