

Title: GCKids Associate Coordinator (Part-time, 20 hours per week)

Objective: The GCKids Associate Coordinator works in partnership with the GCKids leadership team and volunteers to facilitate our mission of leading kids to find and follow Jesus. Assists in engaging volunteers and overseeing all aspects of our Sunday morning classroom ministry environments. Works to support structure and plans for age-appropriate classroom learning experiences ages 3 through pre-teen (4th and 5th grades). Assists with recruiting volunteer leaders. Promotes a culture of engagement making use of unique passions and gifts. Supports a team-of-teams structure to help maximize spiritual impact within GCKids ministry programing.

Reports to: GCKids Pastor

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Sunday Classroom Experiences:
 - Assists with planning weekly Sunday Morning classroom experiences for ages 3 to preteen (grades 4/5).
 - Coordinates and manages weekend volunteer resourcing for classroom environments in alignment with overall ministry vision.
 - Supports the design of classroom environments in alignment with scope and sequence of curriculum.
 - Recruits and trains robust volunteer teams. Assists with onboarding, encouraging, and mobilizing classroom volunteers.
 - Proactive family and volunteer soul care (weekly proactive reach out to families and volunteers).
 - Ensures all classroom supplies and needs are ready and available weekly.

• Other Responsibilities:

- Manages time and productivity to ensure regular worship service attendance.
- o Implements GCKids Ministry safety and security policies and procedures.
- Connects with and develops relationships with volunteers, children, and families through open communication.
- Assists with volunteer and programming needs for Vacation Bible School
- Attends GCKids Team meetings (Grace Chapel Staff Chapels are optional).
- Participates in events/programs outside of normal programming as needed.
- Documents and maintains the processes required to perform the job.
