READ DANIEL 3:1-7

■ What have you found in your own life regarding trials and difficulties? Looking back now, what was the result and how did God use those times? What did He show you?	
☐ If we were to interview Daniel's friends, what might they say was the reason why they choose to take this stand and not bow?	
■ What fuels your devotion to God?

Read Romans 12:2. In what ways does understanding this passage help us?
