DISCUSSION

READ LUKE 17:11-19

- Read Luke 17:11–19. As you imagine what it would be like to live with leprosy in ancient Israel, what do you picture it being like? What emotions might you be experiencing?
- What do you make of their request to Jesus? What do you think they were asking?
- Explain mercy in your own words.
- What other options might these men have had?
- What do you learn about Jesus from this account?
- Why did only one return? What might the others have been thinking, not thinking, or experiencing?
- Why is gratefulness essential for our Christian walk?
- The one man came to Jesus and then returned. What does it mean to come to Jesus like the man did a second time? What might that look like today?
- Read Matthew 11:28–29. What are some of the things that cause us to trust Jesus in this way – to come to Him for real rest?
