Devoted: Living for THE LIVING GOD, Even When...

He has proven to be trustworthy in the stories of Scripture and in the many lives of Christians who have gone before you, so why would you not trust Him? All of us find ourselves at the crossroads of a decision to trust God or not in our own circumstances. Will you?

THIS WEEK:

- Write an “I trust you because...” statement to God and pray it to Him.
- Memorize Psalm 91:15, “When he calls to Me, I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble; I will rescue him and honor him.”
- Post on social media ten reasons why I trust God for WHO HE IS not just what He does.
- Show kindness to another person as a way of remembering God’s kindness to me.

DISCUSSION

- Read Daniel 6:12–28. As you imagine these events, and more specifically if you were going through this, what would you be feeling, thinking, or doing?
- Daniel trusted God. What does that mean in every day and in difficult circumstances? What difference does it make to trust God?
- Read Psalm 91:15. Is this a guarantee? What are we to believe about God?
- Read Psalm 57:4–5. What have you learned or experienced in life that relates to these verses?
- How does a person get to a point where they trust God more—how do we grow in our faith?
- What are we promised? Does God always deliver?
